Recommended Materials List

- 1 x A3 Size Layout Pad "Canson" brand (Bank or Bond Paper)
- Graphite Pencils, Grades 2H, HB, 2B, 4B. (recommend either Faber Castell or Staedtler Lumograph, the blue ones)
- Kneadable Pencil Eraser
- Pencil Sharpener or Stanley Knife
- Fine sandpaper or sandpaper pad (for sharpening pencil points)
- 1 Sheet of Stonehenge White Drawing Paper, or good quality smooth drawing paper
- Drawing board (cheap Mont Martre or Jasart will be fine) with clip and hand carry hole
