# 2016 budget

- 2014 budget plus 4.3% (\$10,455,390)
- Academic & Professional salaries (contract & continuing) are 81% of budget
- Academic casuals & professional casuals are 10% of budget
- Remaining (9%) covers all capital equipment & maintenance, HDR, lab consumables, printing, operational expenses, strategic funds, etc
- **issues**: salary increases, return of Future Fellows, new appointments, BIOL116

# Some changes for 2016

### **HDR budgets**

- Faculty decree of \$3k per student per year, max \$12k over candidature
- Can have some flexibility across candidature

### **Department lab support**

• Previously \$1500 p.a., now moved to strategic funds

Strategies for increasing efficiency in teaching

**Casual academic costs** (~\$750,000)

(1) Reduce number of pracs offered within units

• Aim for max of 10

(2) Reduce standard prac time to 2 hours

(3) Reduce exam time to 2 hours max

(4) Increase efficiency of assessment (e.g. 10% reduction in marking = \$12k)

(5) Academic staff shift from marking to more face-to-face teaching

### Strategies for increasing efficiency in teaching

### **Casual professional costs** (~\$260,000)

(1) Minimise weekend work for technical staff

- Think about OCS times eg OCS1 Saturday, OCS2 mid-semester 2-3 days, OCS 3 Saturday
- Do not schedule OCS on a public holiday
- Talk with Rekha to optimise use of technical staff time across units

(2) External offerings with <15 students on weekends – technical staff will not attend but will set up on the Friday

(3) Consider external offerings in alternate years

## 2016 Strategic research initiatives

### • Strategic research funding (competitive):

- 2 rounds per year (Feb, July)
- to cover activities such as hosting workshops, development of grant proposals, visits to collaborators, training in research methodologies etc
- ~\$22,500 on offer per round (grants up to \$5000 each)

### • Cash contributions for grants (competitive):

- 2 rounds per year (Feb, July)
- For schemes requiring department co-contribution
- ~\$15,000 on offer per round

Can only hold one grant at a time
