**Australian Postgraduate Research Intern (APR. Intern)** is Australia's only national PhD internship program spanning all sectors and disciplines. The program connects PhD students with industry through short-term research projects, giving businesses access to Australia's brightest emerging research talent.

An Australian Government 90% rebate is now available to businesses that place a domestic PhD student intern. Project costs include a \$3K monthly student scholarship, a one-off \$5.5K academic mentor fee and a one-off \$5.5K project management fee.
